Language lover fact

You may be interested to know that Spanish isn't the official language of *Las Islas Baleares*. Catalan, which is spoken in the northeast of Spain, is the language most spoken by the Islands residents. In fact, the official name for the Islands is *Illes Balears*, which is in Catalan language. In English we can refer to them as The Balearic Islands.

Amazing architecture!

The biggest cathedral in the city of Mallorca, called *La Seu*, looks like a huge castle beside a lake. The building started in 1229 (791 years ago!). It took over 400 years to be built.

The type of architecture used is called 'Gothic Style' and the building can be seen from the Mediterranean Sea.

La seu is 121m long, 40m wide, and 44m tall.
